RPEQ Certification

WHAT IS RPEQ AND WHY DO I NEED THIS?

Professional Engineers Act 2002 (PE Act) requires that any person who provides professional engineering services in Queensland or any person who designs a building, plant, machinery or product for use in Queensland must be registered as a registered professional engineer (RPEQ) or acting under the direct supervision of an RPEQ.

Professional engineering service is defined in the Act as being an engineering service that acquires, or is based on, the application of engineering principles and

data to a design, or to a construction or production activity relating to engineering.

Professional engineering services undertaken outside Queensland on the design, construction, and maintenance systems for any building, plant, machinery or product for use in Queensland must be undertaken by an RPEQ. Alternatively a RPEQ in Queensland must be in a position to take responsibility for the professional engineering services provided. The RPEQ must have in place documented mechanisms and quality assurance systems to ensure the standard and appropriateness of the services provided.

Certification by an RPEQ is **ESSENTIAL** for most Engineering work carried out in Queensland. Independent certification is your guarantee of quality and peace of mind.
